RESOLUTION :

In partial modification of the orders issued in Government
Resolution, General Administration Department No. EXD-1076/
2463/XVII, dated the 19th April, 1979 regarding grant of
exemption from passing the departmental examination to the
Government servants, who attain the age of 45 years on 1st
November, 1977 or thereafter, Government is pleased to clarify
further that the orders issued in Government Resolution, General
Administration Department No. EXD 1076/2463/XVII, dated the 19th
April, 1979 apply to the gazetted officers only, who according
to the recruitment rule are liable to be discharged for not
passing the prescribed departmental examination during the
period of probation, and not to the non-gazetted direct recruits
in Government service.

2. The Mantralaya Departments are requested to take into
consideration the above clarification while amending the
relevant Departmental Examination Rules in accordance with the
instructions contained in para 2 of the Government Resolution,
General Administration Department No. EXD 1076/1945/137/XVII,
dated the 1st November, 1977.
